June 13th is a day we will always remember. On 6/13 in Israel, the Mossad and IDF bravely began its comprehensive preemptive strike, Operation Rising Lion, (see Numbers 23:24) to protect itself AND the rest of the Western world from the danger of an Iranian nuclear attack. In response, sadly, and not unexpectedly, we witnessed Iran launch an unparalleled wave of attacks on Israel. As Netanyahu explained, "We have internalized the lessons of history. When an enemy says he intends to destroy you-believe him. When the enemy develops the capabilities to destroy you-stop him."

I am overflowing with pride for Israel for doing what no other country would to keep us all ultimately safe from Iranian aggression. I am grateful for our country's focused attack on Iran's three nuclear facilities. At the same time, I pray and worry for the safety of all Israelis and other potential targets during this unprecedented time.

I'd like to share with you a moving piece written by my Conservative colleague Rabbi Menachem Creditor: "I lift my eyes beyond the mountains to the skies, and I see streaks of fire. To the depths of shelters I call, and the response comes once it is safe to emerge: we are here. The Holy One neither slumbers nor sleeps.

Neither does my family, woken by piercing alarms,

as the enemy targets whole families, as it has through proxy hydra heads for decades.

My eyes are exhausted from crying. My heart is exhausted from breaking. But Love is a sustainable resource, and the Source of Love sustains us. We fight for life.

We fight for life.

We rise.

Again and again.

As long as we must.

We fight.

For life."

May the time come speedily when our Israeli brothers and sisters will no longer have to fight for life and fight to help ensure the safety of us all. Looking forward to being together in community for our July 5th Shabbat Kodesh service and again for our Friday service July 25.
