The Hebrew month of *Nisan* began on March 30th, and we celebrate the Passover seders on the 14th and 15th of *Nisan*, this year falling on April 12th and 13th. Our communal seder is Sunday night April 13th, **this time in the comfort of our synagogue instead of at a hotel!**

Our ancestors celebrated Passover differently than how we observe today. When the Temple was standing, Jews were commanded to travel to Jerusalem. At the Temple, they sacrificed a lamb, a reminder of the lamb's blood that the Israelites put on their doors in Egypt, signaling G-d to pass over their homes and not kill their firstborn. They roasted the lamb, made *matzah*, and gathered bitter herbs, sitting down to eat as a family and retelling the story of Passover. And if a family could not afford a lamb, or eat an entire lamb, they would join with another family.

After the Temple was destroyed, our sages decided that Passover would be best celebrated by families at home. *Matzah* became the major symbol of Passover instead of the lamb sacrifice. This is one of the reasons why Passover is also called *Hag Mamatzot*, the Festival of *Matzah*.

Looking forward to celebrating with you at our Shaarey Tzedek community seder and enjoying our Friday night service together on April 25!
